The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

On the last Sunday of His life, Jesus was welcomed into Jerusalem by the crowd's cry of "Hosanna" and proclaimed to be the "Son of David." Little did the multitude realize that the Messiah had entered the holy city with the primary purpose of laying down His life as the one-time, sufficient sacrifice for their sins. During the days that followed, Jesus challenged the religious leaders and taught His disciples as He set His face toward the completion of His earthly mission. Of course, the week culminated with the celebration of the Passover meal, Judas' betrayal, various "trials," and Jesus' death. For many, the week that had begun with a coronation had quickly ended with a crucifixion.

This Palm Sunday, we will come together to celebrate the cross and its consequences. On the surface, that seems strange, doesn't it? Celebrating death? And yet, living on this side of the Christ event allows clearer perspective and reflection. We know that Jesus' life was not taken from Him, but rather, He freely laid His life down. We also know that His death was necessary for the work of salvation. Only through His substitutionary atonement can we receive

I was reminded of how God used a man like Paul to help with the spread of the good news of Jesus. I am thankful that God can use us individually and cooperatively in spreading the news about our Savior.

The people of this community prayed for God to spare them from the Black Plague that swept through Europe in the 1600's. When they were spared, the residents put on the play in gratitude for being spared. They have continued with the tradition every 10 years since then. The play is put on for six months of the year. It is a very impressive event.
