School's out for summer! The memories of my childhood summers are vivid - ice cream, swimming pools, baseball, fishing, sleepovers, travel, and more. With all the fun that summer brings, unfortunately it poses challenges for many families in our parish. Nearly 25% of children in our parish are considered food insecure, and no school means less access to hot meals. This summer, let's work together to help the hungry!

What's the plan? From June 16 - 30 our church will be collecting canned goods for our local ministry partner, Christian Community Action. They will need around 15,000 cans to meet the demand this summer. The more canned goods CCA collects, the less canned goods CCA has to purchase as they seek to meet needs this summer. Over the past two years, Temple has averaged about 600 cans. This year, our goal is **1,000 cans**. Let's go!

Please be praying for our summer mission teams! Temple is on the go! Pray for our youth as they go to Puerto Rico and Oxford, AL. Pray for our college students who will be serving in Calgary, Chicago, Boston, West Palm Beach, Seoul, Korea and more. Pray for our children as they go to Mission Arlington.
