The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

I really don't like change. Or maybe more simply stated, I don't always like having to expend the necessary energy to change. For example, I need to lose about twenty pounds, but I am not wholly committed to giving up my bacon cheeseburgers to achieve that goal. It seems ludicrous that I would have to abandon such joy in my life! And yet, even now, I can hear some of you shouting your encouragement to me: "Forsake the cheeseburgers; lose yourself for the kingdom!" And you are probably right! I should at least moderate my bacon-cheeseburger-eating habits. Maybe I'll begin this week . . . but I urge you to measure your expectations. Don't expect to see a brand new, slimmer pastor in the pulpit this Sunday!

Change can certainly be necessary. We are keenly aware of that in the church itself. Over the past several months, our staff has wrestled with potential changes that we believe can position us for better growth opportunities, and we recently presented those recommendations to our deacon body. Thankfully, our deacons affirmed those decisions and have joined with us in committing themselves to the work ahead. So, beginning in September, our Sunday Morning Worship Services and Sunday School/Bible Study schedule will change a bit. At 9 a.m., we will continue to have our Blended Worship Service in the Sanctuary, as well as a simulcast in the gathering Worship Service (just like we do now). However, we will also have a new Sunday School hour beginning at 9 a.m. At 10:30 a.m., the gathering's second worship service will begin, as will a second Sunday School/Bible Study hour. Perhaps it would be best to put it like this:
