The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

A few years ago, Leslie became enamored with the Mitford series, a collection of books that focused upon the ministry of a smalltown, Episcopal priest who was affectionately called Father Tim. Every evening, I would find her consumed in her literary pursuit as she moved from page to page; and I admit that I dared not interrupt her. Rather, I waited until she emerged from her text and shared Father Tim's journey. On one such occasion, Leslie drew insight from the priest's sermonic prowess and offered her suggestion. "Reg," she said, "I've just discovered the best sermon ever." "Yes?" I responded, not sure where this was about to go. She then related her thought: "Father Tim stepped to the pulpit, opened his Bible to 1 Thessalonians 5:18, and read 'In everything, give thanks.' He then sat down. Isn't that a great sermon? Why don't you preach a message like that?"

Of course, I have never quite delivered such a brief sermon (I know you are shocked!), but I recognize her point. There is something impactful about the simple, all-encompassing truth of that injunction. The straightforward command to believers is give thanks. And what is more? Our gratitude should be expressed in every imaginable context, in every imaginable way.

She was also one of the many students who came to our Grand Opening for the Youth Room this fall, but she also accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior on that Grand Opening night. Her parents were not involved in church and apprehensive about coming, but they came to see their daughter be baptized. Since then, this family has been fairly consistent in attending *the gathering* worship service each week! God has worked in the life of this teenage girl, and He is now working through her life in very big ways! It's a huge success story for our church, Youth Ministry; but more important than these, for God Himself!

There was also a teenage boy who started a Bible study group with some friends before school a couple of years ago. He didn't have immediate success in reaching large numbers of friends; but after a year of meeting, this group grew significantly. One of the newer members of this group was a young man who was just starting to figure out what a relationship with God really meant for his life. He was invited to church, started coming, and became more and more confident as his relationship with God grew. Boy #1 was learning real discipleship of his peers as he ministered to boy #2. This year, schedule changes has kept boy #1 from being able to lead his Bible study group before school as in the past. Yet because of his discipling efforts, boy #2 has taken some leadership in this group and has become a growing leader himself. This is very real discipleship – even a great example for adults. It's a win for our church and our Youth Ministry.
