After the 2005-2006 Sunday School year, Temple averaged 783 in Sunday School each Sunday. Twelve years later, we averaged 1050 for the 2017-2018 year. That is a 34% increase in attendance. Why or how did this happen when we hear from so many sources that churches are plateaued or even in decline? My answer is "obedience." When Jesus gave the Great Commission as to what we are to do, you actually obeyed. "Go, make disciples, and teach them to observe His commandments" are directions that you have obeyed. The chief discipleship method in our church is through our weekly Bible study groups (Sunday School). You have invited people to your classes. You have visited people when they were in the hospital, brought meals to the bereaved, and invited the lost and unchurched to hear God's Word. Dr. Thom Rainer, President of LifeWay, tells us that most Americans, even in very unchurched areas, will go to Bible study or worship with a believer IF THEY ARE ASKED. You asked, and God has blessed that obedience by allowing us to grow and continue to be a healthy church. Because you asked, we had to begin new groups to hold all the new people. Thank you for your obedience.
