## The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

Everyone wants to do what is right in making **donations for Hurricane Harvey Disaster Relief**. Let me give you my perspective based on my experiences as the Louisiana Baptist Convention Disaster Relief Director during hurricanes Katrina and Rita. It is fashionable this year on social media to tell people not to give to the American Red Cross, the largest disaster relief group in the USA. I have discovered this campaign to discredit ARC is actually from a new group which wants to gain some of the disaster relief dollars for their own purposes. Southern Baptist Disaster Relief partnered with ARC and the Salvation Army in cooking over 14,000,000 meals during Katrina and Rita alone. They provided the food, and we cooked the meals. I am glad we partner with these two agencies. Did you know that Southern Baptist Disaster Relief is the third largest disaster relief group in the country, only coming in behind the Red Cross and the Salvation Army. You can make very safe donations through Temple to go to *Rolling Hills*, a very viable part of Southern Baptist Disaster Relief, and the Louisiana Baptist Convention.

Our **Home Bible Study Groups** will study "Go Fish" by Andy Stanley on **Sunday evenings from September 17 through October 8**. Sunday School classes will meet in homes from **5:30 – 6:30 p.m.** on these Sundays. *Childcare is available via advance registration*.
