The Pastor's Perspective Dr. Reggie Bridges

No doubt, Tech has gotten back in full swing! As the new quarter begins, I recognize the vast gospel opportunities we have all around us. Our university campus is filled with individuals who need to hear the good news of Christ and experience relationships within the faith community. I was excited that we had approximately 1200 in worship this past week, but I am reminded that the number represents a small fraction of our city and college. Our resolve must be to reach the nations themselves... even those who literally live in our backyard. This week, I encourage you to look for "divine appointments" to share your faith with someone around you.

Also, I ask you to consider your financial support for the missionary endeavor here in the state of Louisiana. Through the collection of what we call the Georgia Barnette State Missions Offering, we support church planting/compassion ministries/disaster relief/etc. throughout our own state. Of course, many of our fellow believers in South Louisiana continue to struggle with the aftermath of the devastating floods (from both last year and this year!). Through our collective giving, Louisiana Baptists have already responded to the crisis, and we will continue to assist in the effort. Rolling Hills Disaster Relief, specifically, has sent feeding, laundry, and shower units to South Louisiana and South Texas, some of which have been manned by Templites. Through local churches, they have distributed gift cards as well to affected residents. (And for our part as a church, we have not only supported Rolling Hills, but we have also hosted teams at our church overnight and helped pack/send supplies to Rockport, Texas.)

The Georgia Barnette resources can even touch our local communities. For example, some of these funds assisted the expansion of Bethlehem Hispanic Mission in Vienna. Many of you remember that we helped this Hispanic mission get its start right here in our Temple Chapel. Now they have assumed the facilities at Vienna Baptist Church, and their fellowship is growing! Through the resources of local churches and the Georgia Barnette State Missions Offering, we will continue to see God's work accomplished among the nations . . . again even when the nations have arrived in our backyard! To date, we have collected \$11,419 of our \$26,500 goal for Georgia. In a time of great need, I pray we would step up and multiply our contributions to our state missions offerings!

On a final note, we are launching a four-week study this Sunday night aimed at challenging us to share the story of Christ with others. I encourage you to gather with your Sunday School class (and its associates!) in a home setting to study Andy Stanley's Go Fish and discuss what it means to live out the Christ-life daily. If for some reason you cannot make it to a home or small group context, I will be sharing the same study in the Chapel on Sunday nights. You can begin dropping your children off at 5 p.m., but they **must be picked up by 7 p.m.** Studies, (including our Chapel venue), will begin at 5:30 p.m. Hope to see you Sunday!


